Instructors Code of Ethics

Be committed to providing a quality service to your students

1. Treat everyone equally regardless of gender, age, race or religion. Display control, respect, dignity and professionalism to all involved in your Martial Art. This includes your students, opponents, coaches, officials, parents and spectators. Preparation and presentation of lessons should display the highest standards.
2. For insurance reasons lessons should consist only of that which you are qualified and insured to teach.
3. Present a professional image at all times, this includes punctuality, wearing a clean fresh uniform and refraining from bad language.
4. Endeavour to maintain and improve your fitness and skills.
5. Strive to be a positive role model for your Association and Students.

Legal Implications

6. Ensure that your Insurance Policy and First Aid Certificates are kept up to date. Maintain appropriate records. Membership forms should be completed and a Code of Conduct given to new Students before training commences.
7. Ensure your Students' licences are kept up to date.
8. In the event of an accident, you should complete and sign an accident form as soon as possible. The injured person and a witness (where possible), should also sign the form.
9. When conducting lessons be aware of safety hazards such as weight differences when performing power techniques and space problems when performing swinging and spinning techniques.
10. Always be alert to any form of bullying and if necessary refer the student to his/her Code of Conduct
11. Any physical contact with your Students should be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the Student's skill development.

12. If you have any concerns regarding your Clubs or in respect of situations that may arise amongst Instructors, these should be reported to a Senior Instructor or discussed at the Instructors Meetings.
13. You should not discuss fellow Instructors with Students or lower Grades, except to promote them in positive terms.
14. Any skills taught to you under NWCKB should not be displayed in competition or other events without official permission.
